The Cancer Education Center at Swedish is a unique resource center that provides patient education to the public free of charge. The center offers a wide variety of brochures, books, videos and audiotapes about cancer, and an expansive computer database that can be used to search for and print information about specific types of cancer.

Services available

The Cancer Education Center services include:

- Complimentary brochures
- Internet access
- Lending library and retail books for sale
- Retail items designed to support the needs of cancer patients, such as books, hats, scarves, sleepwear, skin-care products and more
- Anatomical models for practicing self-exams

Visitors can search the database or have a staff member conduct a free search. Staff will also compile a customized packet upon request that can be picked up or sent in the mail.
